If the weather is bad, we will hide them in the fellowship hall for an indoor hunt.



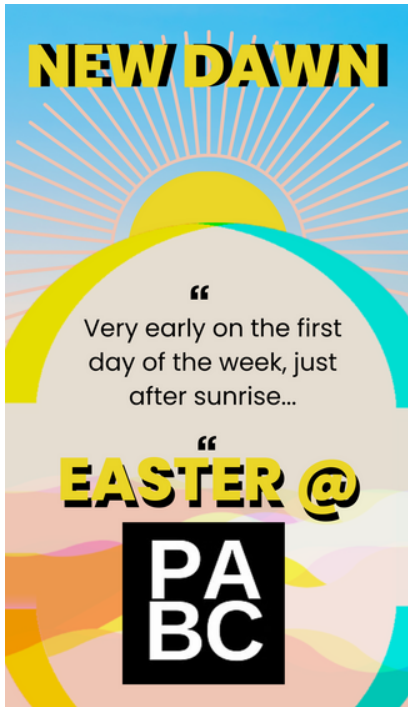
GOOD FRIDAY SERVICE

Email Pastor Darci for the link to register. All people who live in the building have been invited.



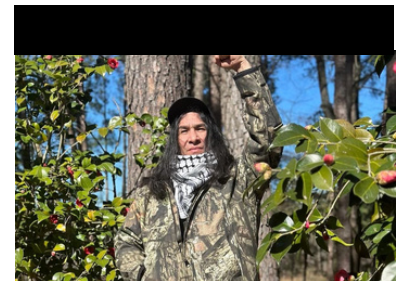

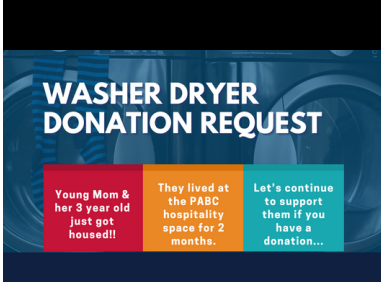


SERVICE SUCCESS
